<b>Advanced Night Vision Goggles</b>  (ANVG)	<b>Description:</b> Advanced Low Visibility Shooting Training Using Night Vision Goggles (NVG).  <b>Prerequisites:</b> Completed FRC, ARC and NVG courses



## Event Summary

This training event addresses the needs of civilian clients willing to improve their skills, tactics, and resilience, to ensure they are well-prepared for modern warfare challenges. It builds on top of the Basic Rifle Course.

NCTS extends this proposal towards candidates seeking group training (up to 18 participants) organized and conducted by **former GROM operators**.

Events will be held in Wiechlice Airbase Shooting Range (<https://airbase-range.com/>) – one of the largest shooting ranges in Europe.

## About NCTS

## Training Structure and Cycles

The training will take place over two full days between Friday and Sunday, with the exact timeline adjusted to participants' arrival times.

## Provided Equipment

**!** This training assumes that the participants provide their own equipment and ammo rounds.

Upon request and against an additional charge, NCTS will provide each participant with the following equipment for the training sessions:

<b>Optics</b>	Eotech EXPS red dot (holographic) sights (or similar quality)
<b>Lasers</b>	DBAL A2/PEQ-15
<b>Steel Targets</b>	MTS Targets



# Roles and Responsibilities

## Responsibilities of the participants

Unless the participant did no request the equipment to be provided by NCTS, they are required to:

- provide their own type AR-15 rifle with sling; the rifle should be equipped with Aimpoint or Eotech optoelectronics
- provide at least 1200 rounds of 5.56 × 45mm ammunition
- provide eye and ear protection

## Responsibilities of NCTS

- Preparation and conducting of training sessions.
- Securing weapons and ammunition during the sessions.
- Medical assistance during the sessions.

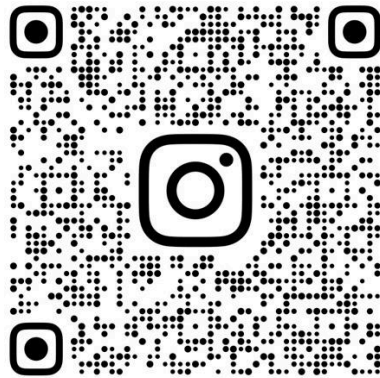
Providing catering during the training sessions.If group training is conducted (i.e., not individual sessions), one instructor will be required for every six participants.
